

The Armor of God: Shield of Faith Ephesians 6:10-12, 16; Genesis 6–9; Hebrews 11:7



Here's what happens...

Paul talks about the spiritual battle we're fighting against evil, and he tells us to carry a shield of faith. Like a shield, faith protects our hearts because we trust that God will keep his promises. Noah did just that when he obeyed God and built an ark to prepare for the flood. Like Noah, we can have faith.

Bible Point:

We fight evil with faith.

"Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm" (Ephesians 6:13).

Family Together Time

- Have your family work together to decorate a shield of faith.
- You could draw a shield shape on a regular piece of paper or go big and put it on a poster board!
- Decorate inside the shield with words or pictures that show things your family likes as well as things your family believes about God.
- Hang the shield on your door so you see it every time you leave home.
